

RESOLUTION NO. 2553

A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH THE FINDINGS OF MULTNOMAH COUNTY RESOLUTION 2021-084 – SLOPE EASEMENT VACATION ON NE 257TH DRIVE

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The slope easement affected by this proposed vacation was acquired by Multnomah County in 1986 in conjunction with the construction of NE 257th Drive.
2. Get R Done LLC, an Oregon limited liability company, had submitted a petition to vacate the slope easement in compliance with ORS 368.341(3) as part of a condition of approval to allow for the development of land upon which this slope easement is contained.
3. The Board of County Commissioners for Multnomah County adopted Resolution No. 2021-084 on November 18, 2021 to initiate the vacation, subject to further action on behalf of the County and the City of Troutdale as described therewithin.
4. Pursuant to ORS 368.361(3) and Section 3 of Resolution No. 2021-084, the City of Troutdale is required to adopt a local resolution which concurs with the County's findings from the aforementioned resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT BE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

- Section 1. The City of Troutdale is in support of the application to vacate this slope easement.
- Section 2. The City of Troutdale concurs with the findings from Multnomah County Resolution 2021-084 as provided in Attachment A.
