## Cindy,

We have received several complaints about vehicles parking along E  $10^{th}$  Street right at the corner to E  $9^{th}$  Street. Across from Heka Park. These vehicles are making it unsafe for motorists to make the turn and see oncoming traffic who are turning East on to E  $10^{th}$  Street. My recommendation would be to add 30 feet of yellow curb in between the two driveways. Also we would want to add a "NO PARKING" sign along the fence. I have attached a drawing of my recommendation.
