RESOLUTION NO 2263

**IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WARRENTON TO
APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT TO THE
OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR TRAIL
IMPROVEMENTS AND REHABILITATION OF RESTROOM
FACILITY AND PARKING AREA AT EBEN H. CARRUTHERS MEMORIAL
PARK; DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.**

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements, and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of City Commissioners have identified improvements at Eben H. Carruthers Memorial Park as a high priority need in the City of Warrenton, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes construction of the 10 foot wide, 0.5 mile trail to be the next feasible section in completing Warrenton's trail network; including parking lot and restroom improvements; and

WHEREAS, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time; and


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the City Commission authorizes City of Warrenton Staff to apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for construction and rehabilitation at Eben H. Carruthers Memorial Park as specified above; and supports the 26-mile trail loop.
