

RESOLUTION NO. 96-054

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 94-106,
CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF BALLOT MEASURE 8
FOR NON-UNION EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 94-106 on December 12, 1994, implementing the provisions of Ballot Measure 8 for non-union employees effective July 1, 1995; and


WHEREAS, in the case of Oregon State Police Officer's Association, et. al., v. State of Oregon, 323 Or. 356 (1996), the Oregon Supreme Court held the provisions of Ballot Measure 8 requiring employees to contribute 6% of their salary to their retirement plans, were unconstitutional, which has the effect of overruling Resolution No. 94-106; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Resolution No. 94-106 is hereby repealed.
