A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 94-106, CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF BALLOT MEASURE 8 FOR NON-UNION EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 94-106 on December 12, 1994, implementing the provisions of Ballot Measure 8 for non-union employees effective July 1, 1995; and

WHEREAS, in the case of <u>Oregon State Police Officer's</u>

Association, et. al., v. State of Oregon, 323 Or. 356 (1996), the Oregon Supreme Court held the provisions of Ballot Measure 8 requiring employees to contribute 6% of their salary to their retirement plans, were unconstitutional, which has the effect of overruling Resolution No. 94-106; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 94-106 is hereby repealed. PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS 25TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1996.
