## RESOLUTION NO. 96-009

A RESOLUTION DENYING STREET VACATION NO. 24-96, CONCERNING A PORTION OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF EAST 16TH STREET ADJACENT TO PROPERTIES LOCATED AT 2525 EAST 16TH, 2610 EAST 15TH STREET, AND 2618 EAST 15TH STREET

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing concerning Street Vacation No. 24-96 on February 12, 1996, and following the close of the public hearing, the Council voted to continue their deliberations until February 26, 1996; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 1996, the City Manager, City Attorney, and Community & Economic Development Director met with Mr. and Mrs. Scott Gayer and their attorney, and Mr. and Mrs. Brendon Irvine, to discuss concerns raised by the Gayers as to the impact of the proposed street vacation upon adjacent properties owned by the Gayers; and

WHEREAS, information presented at this meeting established the Gayers had purchased the adjacent properties with the expectation that access to the properties would be provided through the portion of East 16th Street which was proposed to be vacated, and that the proposed street vacation would significantly affect the market value of the Gayers' properties, which would require the City to compensate the Gayers for the damage to their properties; and

WHEREAS, in view of the fact that approval of the requested street vacation would require the expenditure of public funds which have not been approved or allocated in the budget process, and evidence indicating the subject portion of East 16th Street may need to be retained to provide street access for adjacent parcels, the Council finds the requested street vacation is not in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Street Vacation No. 24-96 is hereby denied.
