A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ADDITIONAL **OREGON STATE POLICE TROOPERS**

WHEREAS, District IV of the Oregon State Police provides policing services, assistance, and back-up to the City of The Dalles; and

WHEREAS, the number of Oregon State Police Troopers has been declining over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined an additional 220 troopers are needed throughout the State, with 18 positions identified to provide needed services in District IV; and

WHEREAS, these additional positions would provide a wide range of services, which include meeting Cooperative Local Policing Agreements, increased patrols, and increased support to local police agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS **FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Support for Additional Troopers. The City Council recognizes the need for additional Oregon State Police Troopers throughout the State, and especially in District IV, and supports additional State funding in the next biennium for the needed positions, stated in this Resolution. The City Council strongly urges other local agencies to formally support the effort to increase the number of State Troopers, thus increasing the safety of our citizens.
