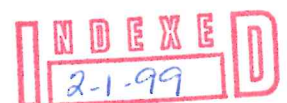
INITIATING A STREET VACATION PROCEDURE FOR THE FULL WIDTH OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF KELSAY WAY, CHENOWITH HOME TRACTS, FROM KELSAY WAY'S EASTERN INTERSECTION WITH WEST 6TH STREET (HWY. 30) TO THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE DEDICATED RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the City has received a petition from Mr. Harold Good to initiate a street vacation for the full width of Kelsay Way between West 6th Street and the western boundary of said right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has found that the petitioner, Mr. Good, has met State statutory requirements found in ORS 271.080 which regulate petitions for street vacations; and

WHEREAS, the petition to vacate has been reviewed by City Public Works, Planning and Police Departments, the Northern Wasco Co. PUD, Northwest Natural, Mid-Columbia Fire and Rescue, the Oregon Department of Transportation, and the other franchise utilities, with issues identified to be presented in a staff report to be prepared for a street vacation public hearing; and

WHEREAS, under ORS 271.100, the City Council shall, if there appears to be no reason why the petition should not be allowed in whole or in part, set a time for a formal hearing on the petition;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Street Vacation Petition Initiated. Street Vacation No. 35-98, which is further described on the attached maps, is hereby initiated, and will be formally heard by Council at a public meeting on February 22, 1999.

Section 2. Officers to Act. The City Planning Department is directed to post and publish notice for the street vacation hearing initiated in Section 1, according to the provisions of ORS 271.110, and to prepare a staff report to Council recommending a decision on the proposed vacation.
