A RESOLUTION DECLARING A PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST, SECTION 10AB, TAX LOT NUMBER 7500, AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of The Dalles owns a 1.14 acre of real property described as Township 1 North, Range 13 East, Section 10AB, Tax Lot Number 7500, which parcel is shown on the map attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City has received inquiries from prospective buyers interested in purchasing a portion or all of the entire parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City staff site team has reviewed the proposal to declare the parcel as surplus real property, and has determined there is no public need for the City to retain ownership of the subject parcel; and

WHEREAS, ORS 271.310 provides that a political subdivision may sell, exchange, convey or lease for any period not exceeding 99 years all or any part of its interest in real property, when that property is not needed for public use, or whenever transfer of the property may further the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the recommendations of City staff concerning the proposal to declare the property as surplus; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The parcel of land described as Township 1 North, Range 13 East, Section 10AB, Tax Lot Number 7500, as shown on Exhibit "A", is declared to be surplus property, not needed for public use. A transfer of the property will further the public interest based upon the following reasons:

The subject parcel appears to have limited potential for use for development by the City. As long as the parcel remains in public ownership, no property taxes will be assessed upon the property. The primary value of the property appears to consist of its development value for a residential dwelling. If the parcel is sold and developed, the property taxes which will be assessed will generate additional revenue for local government.
