

RESOLUTION NO. 02-016

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN "EXCESSIVE FORCE POLICY" IN ACCORDANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMMUNITY BLOCK DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of The Dalles has been advised that the City has been awarded a \$150,000 grant under the Community Block Development Program, which funds are to be used in connection with the construction of the Union Street Underpass Project; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of the Community Block Development Program is that the City adopt a policy concerning the use of "excessive force" against individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt the required policy to comply with the requirements of the Community Block Development Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE DALLES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Policy Adopted. The City Council declares that it is the policy of the City that (1) its law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and (2) applicable state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.

Section 2. Effective Date. The resolution adopting this policy shall be considered effective as of July 15, 2002.




