RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08

WHEREAS, Chapter VII, Section 33 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon requires that an elected office shall be deemed vacant upon the incumbent's resignation; and

WHEREAS, at the April 13, 2022 City Council Meeting City Councilor Jason Bolen announced his resignation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to conduct interviews for a replacement at the May 25, 2022 City Council Meeting, with a swearing in at the June 8, 2022 meeting; and

WHEREAS, City Councilor Jason Bolen's term does not expire until December 31, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lebanon:

Section 1. The City Council seat of Jason Bolen, Ward 3, is hereby declared vacant effective 12:01 AM on April 14, 2022 and shall be filled through appointment by a majority of the incumbent members of the Council.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.


