## Resolution No. 22-07

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERING AMOUNTS FROM CONTINGENCY TO MATERIALS AND SERVICES WITHIN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND # 102.

WHEREAS, ORS 294.463(2) provides guidance for the transfer of contingency to an appropriation category which is less than 15% in aggregate of the adopted budget's total fund appropriations. The contingency transfer is 1.4% of the total fund appropriations.

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing the transfer of appropriations within the Capital Improvement Fund is required after adoption of the FY 2021-2022 budget.

WHEREAS, the adjusted budgets are on file in the office of the Director of Finance and Administrative Services at City Hall.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ASTORIA:

Transferring \$ 30,000 from Personnel Services to Materials and Professional Services to cover for emergent repair costs associated with failed storm drain in Evergreen Field and time constraints associated with Astoria Middle School track improvements which are adjacent to Evergreen Field. The total requirements remain the same for this fund.
