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## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING DECISION

Historic Landmarks Commission 204-22 Todd Carpenter and Carla McQuade

**DECISION DATE**: April 29, 2022

**APPLICANT**: Todd Carpenter and Carla McQuade

**REQUEST:** Approval to restore original windows on street level alley, add safety

railing, and restore doorway access with a roll-up door to second level

patio area.

**LOCATION**: The property is located at 215 E. Second Street, further described as 1N

13E 3 BD tax lot 3500. Property is a non-compatible, non-contributing resource located in the National Commercial Historic District. Property is zoned CBC – Central Business Commercial with a CBC-1 and CBC-2

Overlay.

**PROPERTY** 

**OWNER**: City of The Dalles

**AUTHORITY**: The Dalles Municipal Code, Chapter 11.12 Historic Resources

**DECISION:** Based on the findings of fact and conclusions in the staff report of HLC 204-22, and after a hearing in front of the Historic Landmarks Commission on April 27, 2022 the request by Todd Carpenter and Carla McQuade is hereby **approved** with the following conditions:

- 1. Work shall be completed in substantial conformance to the pictures and proposals as submitted, reviewed and modified.
- 2. The use of reflective and smoked glass is prohibited.
- 3. Whenever possible, the natural color of the materials should be retained.
- 4. The modification to the rear façade shall not alter the essential form and integrity of the historic property. Utmost care will be taken with new construction.
- 5. The applicants shall submit plans for a building permit to City of The Dalles and then Wasco County Building Codes.
- 6. Cleaning of the historic structure requires the applicants to use the gentlest means possible. No harsh chemical or sandblasting will be allowed.

- 7. Replacement materials necessary for restoration should be compatible in quality, color, texture, finish and dimension to the original materials.
- 8. The applicants are required to notify the Community Development Department of any alteration of the approved plans.
- 9. Applicant will be given the option to make a final decision on door replacement. Either a metal roll-up door or wood-clad French style door will be allowed.

**APPEAL PROCESS**: The Commission's approval, approval with conditions, or denial is the final decision, and <u>may be appealed to the City Council</u> if a completed Notice of Appeal is received by the City Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on <u>May 9, 2022</u>, the 10<sup>th</sup> day following the date of the mailing of the Notice of Decision. The following may file an appeal of decisions:

- 1. Any party of record to the particular action.
- 2. A person entitled to notice and to whom no notice was mailed. (A person to whom notice is mailed is deemed notified even if notice is not received.)
- 3. The Historic Landmarks Commission, the Planning Commission, or the City Council by majority vote.

A complete record of application is available for review upon request during regular business hours, or copies can be ordered at a reasonable price, at the City of The Dalles Community Development Department. A Notice of Appeal form is available at The Dalles Community Development Department. The fee to file a Notice of Appeal is \$500.00. The appeal process is regulated by The Dalles Municipal Code Chapter 11.12.090.
