1. PUBLIC COMMENT: None

5. DEPARTMENTS:

COMMISSIONERS: No reporting's.

OFFICE: The District manager reminded everyone that the RFP for the Field Operations Maintenance and Bi-Monthly meter reading public notice was published on April 15, 2022. The closing date for this RFP is May 6, 2022. May 13, 2022 is when the proposals will be evaluated.

FIELD OPERATOR: Hydrant replacements are in progress. There is one more hydrant to replace at the end of April 2022. There are four one-inch meters that have been installed at the Waluga Park Estates.

ENGINEER: Current updates on the following projects:

Boones Ferry Improvements: The contractor, Wildish is still working on completing the punch lists. The valve boxes remain on the list. The ribbon cutting ceremony was on April 18, 2022.

Shorenstein: (5600 Meadows): They are mobilized on site with grading, but the utility work is not in progress.

16667/16607 Boones Ferry (Sunset Crossing): The plans and designs have resurfaced and is back in progress.

15570 Waluga Partition – The plans are still under the City to review.

15868 Parker - The isolation valve is still missing, and it is needed to terminate the old service.

Waluga Park Estates: A total of four lots have requested service and 4 1-inch meters have been installed.

Future land developments that are still pending:

- a. Summer Woods/Washington Ct. A 3-lot partition is on hold due to a second neighborhood meeting.
- b. There is a potential five lot development on Baleine and Inverurie.
