REQUEST: Applicant is requesting a reduction in parking standard requirements to facilitate the addition of a mixed-use first floor tenant program to include retail space, and a café and wine sales/tasting room.

PROPERTY OWNER: The Foley LLC

LOCATION: The property is located at 106 E. 4th Street and is further described as 1N 13E 3 BC Tax Lot 2600. Property is zoned CBC – Central Business Commercial District, within the Commercial Historic District and the CBC-1 Overlay.

REVIEW CRITERIA: The Dalles Municipal Code, Title 10 Land Use and Development, Article 3.050 Conditional Use Permits, Article 5.050 CBC – Central Business Commercial District.


1. Signed written comments may be submitted prior to the hearing by mail or personal delivery. Emails will only be accepted if sent to rmarcus@ci.the-dalles.or.us. All comments must include the name and address of the person making the comments. Comments for a quasi-judicial hearing which are longer than one side of one page shall be accepted only by mail or in person and only if 12 copies are presented. Comments must be at least equal in size to ten-point type. Comments must be received by 5 p.m. on the hearing date, or may be presented in person at the hearing. Additional information relating to comments and the quasi-judicial hearing process can be found in

- The Dalles Municipal Code, Title 10 Land Use and Development, Article 3.020.070. The full Code is online at www.ci.the-dalles.or.us.
- 2. Failure to raise an issue during the public hearing process, in person or by letter, or failure to provide statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond to the issue will preclude an appeal to the City Council and the Land Use Board of Appeals based upon that issue.
- Copies of all review criteria and evidence relied upon by the decision maker or evidence provided by the applicant are available for free review or may be purchased at the Community Development Department, 313 Court Street, The Dalles, Oregon 97058. A Staff Report will be available for inspection seven days prior to the hearing.

DECISION PROCESS:

- 1. An application is received, decision date set, and notice mailed to property owners within 300' of the subject property.
- 2. All affected City departments and other agencies are asked to comment.
- 3. All timely comments and the application are weighed against the approval criteria in a Staff Report.
- 4. The provisions of The Dalles Municipal Code and the City of The Dalles Comprehensive Plan must be met.
- 5. A decision is reached by the Planning Commission based on the Findings of Fact in the Staff Report and other evidence submitted.
- 6. Parties of Record (notified property owners, affected public agencies, and other parties who make timely comment) will receive a Notice of Decision.
- 7. Aggrieved parties may appeal a quasi-judicial decision to the City Council within 10 days of the date a Notice of Decision is mailed, subject to the requirements for appeal procedures.



William J. "Bill" Pengra passed into the arms of his Savior, Jesus Christ, and his beloved wife Donna on June 21, 2019, at the age of 95. Bill was born October 19, 1923, in Springfield, Ore., to Arthur and Stella Pengra. He was great grandson to Oregon Pioneers Bynon and Charlotte Stearns Pengra. He attended schools in Eugene and the University of Oregon before his college days were interrupted by WWII.

Bill entered the U.S. Army Air Corp in 1944. After pilot training he was deployed to the European Air Campaign where he was assigned to the Reich Wreckers 306th Bomb Group of the 8th Air Force with the rank of 2nd Lieutenant. He copiloted the B-17 Flying Fortress Bomber plane during 26 combat missions out of the RAF base in England.

In those years, Bill worked as an accountant then opened his own insurance office. Bill and his family were active in the Calvary Baptist Church in The Dalles and his wonderful tenor singing voice made him a requested soloist at church services, weddings and funerals.

The Pengra family moved to Bend in 1970 and Bill worked as an accounting manager for Beaver Coaches, Brooks Resources and Black Butte Ranch.

Richard Patrick Mathew passed away on June 26, 2019, at the age of 88. He was born on a small farm in Smith County Kansas, on October 21, 1930, to Cecil Mathew and Loretta (Gouldie)-Mathew. He learned to work with horses and do farms chores at a very early age. He was a skilled rider and was often seen galloping down the country roads standing upright on his 9 and 7. Shetland ponies bare He was a wonderful back. Sadly, his father husband and loving fadied when he was nine years old and shortly thereafter, the farm's hired man was drafted into military service. Richard, already familiar with working hard, took over the farm hand's du-

ther. The family would spend summers water skiing on the Columbia and camping throughout Oregon with annual trips to Puget Sound for gathering clams and oysters. Every summer they would spend a couple long weekends at Fort Stevens State Park to dig razor clams and play in the ocean. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and looked forward to his annual deer and elk hunting trips and especially loved deep sea fishing for salmon and halibut. He was an amazing cook, soup and chili "enough to feed an army" were his specialty. He was also a master on the gas grill.

In 1972, then Governor Tom McCall and the Oregon Legislature decided to remove over 10,000 roadside advertising billboards, Richard, who was now the ODOT regional sign foreman, was promoted and moved to Salem to work as the Assistant Sign Permits Supervisor In 1978 he became the ODOT Sign Permits Supervisor. He wasn't very well liked by the outdoor advertising companies that were forced to remove their now illegal roadside advertising. Richard retired from ODOT in June 1986 with 30 years of service. He and Pat moved back to The Dalles and bought a 300 acre farm and began raising Arabian horses, goats, sheep and chickens. He and Pat worked on Habitat for Humanity

projects. They also traveled to Belize to work with some friends in the Peace Corp. Richard and Pat loved to dance. They also loved to hop in their truck with their fifth wheel trailer in tow and take off to unexplored regions of the country. They visited every state at least once. In 1996, Richard and

Pat along with their horses, goats, mule, chickens and dogs moved back to the Willamette Valley to be closer to their children and grandchildren.

Richard was a quiet and kind man with a strength and persistence that carried him far in life. He was witty, funny and compassionate. He liked people and people liked him. With his quiet warmth and personal interest, he developed friendships wherever he

He is survived by his wife Pat; his 3 step-children Ruby Haskell, Rick Krause (Shelly Ellingson) and Ron Krause (Vernona); grandchildren LeAnne, Robert, Brittney, Ryan, Shawna, Jason and Georgia; and 11 great grandchildren, Jordan, Andrew, Tyler, Tristen, Zoe, Lily, Jared, Chase, Lexi, Kaley, and Drew and 2 great-great grandchildren, Liam and Arlen.

He remained close to his family in Kansas throughout his life. He is also survived by his sister's children, Joelle Alsheimer, Curtis McCall, Joni Bellerive, Shawn Mc-Call, Patricia Dunlap and Shane McCall.

Richard is preceded in death by his parents Cecil and Loretta (Gouldie) Mathew, his step-father, Lloyd Lala, his sister Elaine McCall, son in law Lindsey Haskell and an older stillborn sibling.
