The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will change the configuration and operation of traffic signals on Tuesday June 14, 2022 at the following location:

The intersection of West 2nd Street and Webber Street – Flaggers will be directing traffic on all travel lanes at this intersection. Expect delays.

To minimize disruption, the work is scheduled at night from 9:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight).

The purpose of this project is to install new left turn signals for the north/south traveling lanes at West 2nd Street and Webber Street to match the operation of the signals at the intersection of West 6th Street and Webber Street. This change is expected to smooth the flow of traffic and improve safety for motorists making left turns.

Please proceed with caution through this intersection during work hours and observe all temporary traffic control devices and flagger directions. Thank you for your attention to traveling safety during this work.
