





TOWER DETAIL NOTES & TECHINCAL SPECS

StarTouch is proposing to install (3) total parabolic antennas using (2) separate FRM non-penetrating roof mounts. One non-pen (labeled antenna array #1) will be placed on the NE comer of Building 1, and the other (labeled antenna array #2) will be placed on the SW corner closest to the roof access hatch. (See exact location of non-pen mounts and the proposed 2" conduit run located on the Field Draft tab)

Antenna array#1 will have (1) 2' and (1) 3' parabolic antennas, one facing 64.59 degrees and one facing 354 degrees StarTouch to run a total of (7) cables: (2) 14/2 power (4) CATSE (1) Fiber.

Antenna array#2 will have (1) 2' parabolic antenna facing 343 degrees. StarTouch to run a total of (4) cables: (1) 14/2 power (2) CATSE (1) Fiber

Startouch equipment will not be visible form the ground.
