A RESOLUTION DEDICATING THE ASTORIA NORDIC HERITAGE ASSOCIATION'S IMPROVEMENTS AT PEOPLE PLACE PARK AS CITY PROPERTY AND DESIGNATING THE SITE AS "ASTORIA NORDIC HERITAGE PARK"

WHEREAS, The Astoria Scandinavian Heritage Association (ASHA) and the City of Astoria (City) entered into an agreement in 2017 allowing ASHA to fundraise for construction of a monument at People Place Park; and

WHEREAS, ASHA has committed to all ongoing maintenance, care, and upkeep of all built, installed, and enhanced items associated with the new monument; and

WHEREAS, The City recognizes and appreciates the historic and continuing contributions of the Nordic community to Astoria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ASTORIA:

The City accepts all improvements dedicated by the Astoria Scandinavian Heritage Association at People Place Park and formally acknowledges that the collective improvements and site will hereafter be named the "Astoria Nordic Heritage Park".
