A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE 2023 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH DEVNW AS SUB-GRANTEE

WHEREAS, The City is a member of the Linn County Housing Rehabilitation Partnership Program in rural Linn County which includes the incorporated cities of Brownsville, Halsey, Harrisburg, Lebanon, Scio, Sodaville, Sweet Home, Tangent, Waterloo, and all unincorporated areas of Linn County; and

WHEREAS, The City is eligible to apply for a 2023 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the Oregon Business Development Department. Community Development Block Grant funds come from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grants can be used for public facilities and housing improvements, primarily for persons with low and moderate incomes; and

WHEREAS, The grant will provide loan and grant funds to income qualifying households to make safety and habitability improvements to homes and some administration and management fees to operate the program. DevNW (formerly Willamette Neighborhood Services) has operated this program since January 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Council of the City of Lebanon herein authorizes the staff to submit an application for the 2023 CDBG and authorizes the City Manager to sign the required documents and contract with DevNW as sub-grantee.

SECTION 1. The Lebanon City Council will accept any CDBG award resulting from this application.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
