

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 84- 323

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL PARKS AND RECREATION NATATORIUM RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of The Dalles has received through its Park Department, the sum of \$ 6,636, and

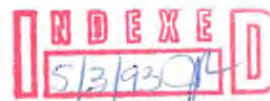
WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and proper to establish the City of The Dalles Special Parks and Recreation Natatorium Fund to repair and replace the equipment and facilities of the City of The Dalles Natatorium, now therefore

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF THE DALLES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Fund Created, Custodians. There is hereby established a City of The Dalles Special Parks and Recreation Natatorium Fund said fund to be under the immediate supervision and control of the City Manager and the City Treasurer.

Section 2: Sources of Money for the Fund. There shall be deposited in said fund a portion of the money received through the City's Parks and Recreation Fund. At least annually, the City Council shall order deposited therein an amount estimated to be sufficient to cover reasonable repairs and replacement of the facilities of the City of The Dalles Natatorium.

Section 3: Expenditures. Funds placed in this fund pursuant to the terms of this ordinance shall be kept by the Treasurer in a fund or funds separate and distinct from other funds of the City and shall be retained and expended only for the purposes for which the fund was created, all as provided in ORS 280.100 and the duration of this fund shall be limited to a



period not to exceed ten (10) years from July 1, 1983 as provided in ORS 280.100.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced and read once in full and by unanimous consent the rules were suspended and it was read the second time by title only and passed this 7th day of May, 1984, by the following vote:
