The traffic control plan will be reviewed per the [Oregon Temporary Traffic Control Handbook](#).
2. Applicants for street or City-owned parking lot closures for events or construction work must provide a **Certificate of General Liability Insurance** with a minimum of \$1,000,000 coverage, with stated purpose of on the Certificate for the event and listing The City of The Dalles, 313 Court St. The Dalles, OR 97058 as a co-insured. Insurance is in addition to acknowledgement of responsibility and cannot be cancelled without prior notice to the City.

Registered Students whose course of study includes on-the-job training, but only while acting under directions and within the scope of their activities performed while in training; f. Organizations that are under the supervision of the administration of the Named Participant, including Student Organizations, Parent Teacher Organizations, Booster Clubs, and Foundations; and g. Any person, entity, or any organization the Named Participant is required by an Insured Contract to include as a Participant. The terms of the Insured Contract will have no effect on either the Per Occurrence Limit of Liability, Per Wrongful Act Limit of Liability or the Annual Aggregate Limit of Liability. The Insured Contract must be effective and executed prior to a covered Occurrence or Wrongful Act.
