- Current rules only allow Title V General Permits for:
 - Major sources not subject to National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants;
 - Numerous similar sources; and
 - Sources with good compliance history and no complaints.




What is a General Permit?

- General permits contain
 - Emissions and limitations;
 - Monitoring;
 - Recordkeeping;
 - Reporting; and
 - Other enforceable conditions


for all operations covered by the general permit

 - Any source required to obtain a Title V permit;


Numerous similar sources; and
