- 2. Opportunity for Public to Comment
- 3. Public Hearing
- 4. EQC Adoption
- 5. File with Secretary of State
- 6. Retain the rulemaking record



What do rules do?

- Rules are an extension of legislatively adopted statutes
- Rules have the power of law
- Rules tell affected parties:
 - What they may do
 - What they must do
 - What they may not do

Advisory Committees

- Discretionary for DEQ, not legally required
- Can help:
 - Obtain stakeholder/public input
 - Address technical issues
 - Aid transparency
 - Provide information on any racial equity impacts
- Fiscal Impact
 - Review DEQ Fiscal Impact Statement
 - Assess fiscal impact on small businesses
