WHEREAS, on August 14, 1996, the Lebanon City Council adopted Section 13.04.580 of the Municipal Code and determined that Utility Rates be established by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the rate structure should be designed to generate revenues adequate to property operate and maintain the wastewater and water systems, to comply with regulatory requirements, to fund system capital projects, and to meet debt service requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council reviews utility rates annually, with this year's evaluation being completed at the April 26, 2023, council work session; and

WHEREAS, a **3.19 percent** increase on the customer's total bill is recommended to cover debt and operating expenses and meet annual revenue targets for capital projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lebanon City Council that the Utility Rates shall be as specifically described in Exhibit "A" (attached hereto) are hereby adopted; and shall be effective July 1, 2023.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 10th day of May 2023, by a vote of **6** yeas and **7** nays.


