The City Administrator presented a comparison of the tax rates, levels of the assessed value and level of services offered in seven other Oregon cities of comparable size. The comparison showed that Newberg's tax rate was very low, and with the proposed tax override of "A" and "B" Ballots would still be only up to the average of these other cities.

Items for the "B" Ballot designation were reviewed.

### SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET 1980-1981

The Supplemental Budget provides for unforseen revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year 1980-1981 ending June 30, 1981.

All expenditures are offset by grants. There are no additional taxes required.

Two grants from the State have been received for the library. The grant of \$1,789 is a per capita grant and can be expended as needed. The second grant of \$2,000 is a mini-grant restricted to expenditures for reference materials.

\$2,071 was received from Mid-Willamette Manpower Consortium to reimburse the City for a CETA trainee. The position was a dispatcher trainee charged to the Fire Department Budget.

A grant of \$6,525 has been received from Land Conservation and Development Commission. This is a maintenance grant for comprehensive planning.
