1200-Z Permit Rulemaking in 2021

- Stormwater discharge water quality general permit

Regulates:

- Marinas and ports
- Airports
- Metal mining
- Lumber mills
- Scrap metal
- Food products



- 2021 permit adopted by reference

Adopted by Reference: OAR 340-045-0033

- Oregon Revised Statute Chapter 183 – Administrative Procedures Act
- ORS 183.335 (7)
Substantive changes to permit meaning = rulemaking

Definition of Terms

Key permit terms:

- Monitoring waiver
- Benchmark
- Tier 1 and Tier 2 corrective action



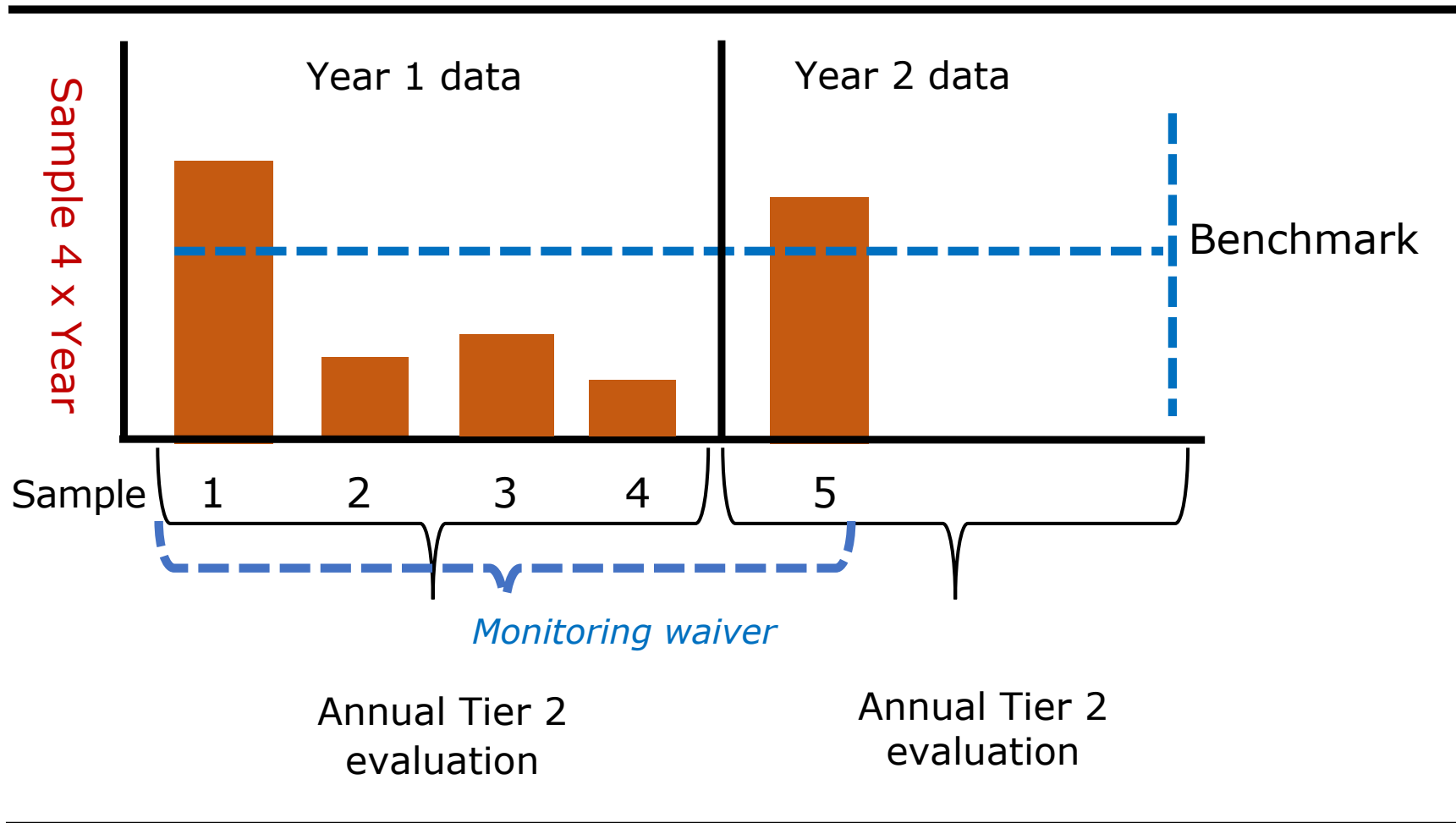
1200-Z Permit Minor Correction Language

Proposed Rulemaking Amendment:

Insert omitted clause, Schedule A.12.a: Tier 2 Corrective Action Response

“Permit registrants are not required to conduct this evaluation for the benchmark parameter(s) for which DEQ or agent has granted a monitoring waiver in accordance with Schedule B.9 of this permit.”

Consequence of Omitted Clause



1200-Z Permit Public Notice

- Public notice: April 29, 2023 – June 7, 2023
- Public hearing: June 6, 2023
- One formal written comment
- Unanimous support
