**Proposed Conditional No Further Action
for Rogue Primary School, VC Site**

Comments due: 5 p.m., Thursday, April 6, 2023
Project location: 615 S. Second St. in Central Point, Jackson County
Proposal: The Department of Environmental Quality is proposing a conditional no further action, or CNFA, determination for the investigation and cleanup of contamination related to underground storage of petroleum products in a concrete vault and a used oil pan on the Rogue Primary School voluntary cleanup site. The site is located on Central Point School District 6 property in Central Point. Conditions of closure include: a contaminated media management plan and worker health and safety plan are followed during any subsurface work in the contaminated areas. This condition will be implemented through a deed restriction that will be recorded with the property prior to issuance of the CNFA. DEQ is proposing to issue a CNFA because the remaining contamination on the site does not pose a risk to human health or the environment with the implementation of the above condition.
