Bryant and Upper Drive – the current plans are to vacuum at the connection to the main line.

16607 & 16667 Boones Ferry have been submitted for the engineer review

Preliminary plans for the abandonment of the 12-inch line on Carman – a redesign has been resubmitted to the contractor.

- b. Three-lot on Babson (5779 Washington Ct.), two new service taps are scheduled for July 5th, and the meter sizing is complete.
- c. Seville -Redevelopment of two homes: The meter has been sized for one site.
- d. 167472 Bonaire Redevelopment here. The owner has been contacted about the District rules.
- e. Habitat for Humanity A preconstruction meeting was held on June 23rd.
- f. 16164 Parker The meter was sized for the rear unit. Scheduling of the tap is pending.
