BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Grantee of said easement shall fill all excavations as soon as practicable after opening; dispose of all brush and debris; and replace in like condition all improvements, trees, ornamental shrubs and crops, if practicable, and as soon as practicable after damage or destruction, but if not practicable, then to pay to the Grantor its successors in interest and assigns, the reasonable value thereof;

BUT BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority make reasonable effort to agree with the owners of the above described real property in respect to compensation, if any, to be paid for said easement and damages, if any, for the taking thereof.

If agreement is not reached in respect thereto, the Manager is authorized to initiate eminent domain proceedings on behalf of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority as provided by law.

A portion of the real property described in Instrument No. 82-06285, as recorded in the Office of the County Clerk, Douglas County, Oregon.

A permanent 25-foot wide sewer easement lying northerly of and adjacent to the southern most line of said property, also being the north right-of-way line of State Highway No. 138.
