

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 4, 7, AND 10 OF THE ROSEBURG URBAN SANITARY AUTHORITY; ESTABLISHING SEWER CHARGES TO BE LEVIED ON ALL USERS DISCHARGING WASTEWATER TO THE WASTEWATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority ("RUSA", herein) to amend Ordinance No. 2 to clarify certain class definitions, and to modify user fees,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of RUSA that Ordinance No. 2 be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1

"Section 3.03 reads as follows:

"Sewer user charges are hereby established, levied and imposed on all users within RUSA. User charges are established for classes of users based upon strength and volume of use. The base for determining volume and strength of a class is the equivalent dwelling unit ("EDU", herein). The standard flow from one EDU will be 400 gallons per day and the standard strength from one EDU will be 200 mg/l of BOD and 200 mg/l of S. S.

"Based on the standard strength for BOD and SS, the following classes of users are established:

CLASS

| I  | <u>Residential</u> - single family homes, mobile homes, combination residences, duplex, triplex, multi-unit apartments, boarding houses, and the like.  | $\frac{\text{BOD+SS}}{2} = 200\text{mg/l}$ |
| II | <u>Low Strength</u> - retail businesses, churches, schools, government agencies, hospitals, laundromats, car washes, each professional office whether a sole building occupant or in a complex, service stations, motels, hotels, and the like. | $\frac{\text{BOD+SS}}{2} = 200\text{mg/l}$ |

III High Strength--restaurants, taverns (with dining), mortuaries, and the like.

$\frac{BOD+SS}{2} > 200 \text{ mg/l}$

IV Industrial User--any user whose discharge volume and/or strength requires compliance with the pre-treatment sections and language of RUSA Ordinance No. 3

"The basis for establishing the BOD and S.S. loading of a user shall be as shown in Appendix A of this Ordinance or as established by the actual testing of the discharge of the user."

SECTION 2

Section 3.04 reads as follows:

The total rate charged a user shall consist of a user charge for debt service, a user charge for operations, including operation, maintenance, and replacement of the treatment works, and a user charge for stream flow augmentation.

- a) The user charge for debt service will be a fixed amount to be charged a user for each EDU of flow per month. The user charge per EDU shall be \$ 3.60.
- b) The user charge for operations including operation, maintenance, and replacement of the treatment works shall be \$ 9.00 for each EDU per month.
- c) For those users who contribute wastewater with strength greater than domestic sewage, a surcharge, in addition to the normal user charge will be collected. The surcharge shall be based on the user's proportionate share of the operation and maintenance (including replacement) of the treatment works.

The total rate to be charged a class of user based upon this Section as follows:

CLASS

I	Residential	\$12.60/month/EDU
II	Low Strength	\$12.60/month/EDU
III	High Strength	As determined individually by calculation
IV	Industrial	As determined individually by Calculation

SECTION 3

Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority Ordinances # 4, 7, and 10 are hereby repealed.
