ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-2.1(B)(2 & 3)OF ORDINANCE NO. 20 OF THE ROSEBURG URBAN SANITARY AUTHORITY.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that SECTION 2-2.1(B)(2 & 3) of Ordinance No. 20 be amended to read as follows:

- (2) Any water or wastes having a pH lower than 5.5 or higher than 11.0 or discharges which will react with water to form products which have a pH value lower than 5.5 or greater than 11.0 or having any other corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structure, equipment and personnel of the POTW unless RUSA approves a variance in such waste because of special conditions in the system, but in no case shall the pH be less than 5.0. Prohibited wastes include, but are not limited to, concentrated acids, alkalies, chlorides, sulfides, and fluoride compounds or any iron pickling wastes or concentrated plating solutions whether neutralized or not;
- (3) Solid or viscous pollutants in amounts which will cause obstruction to the flow in the POTW or other interference with the proper operation of the POTW, and at no time, any water or waste containing floatable grease, oil, fat, or wax; dispersed nonfloatable grease, oil, fat or wax; any garbage, except domestic wastewater discharged from garbage disposal units in private dwellings, that has not been ground or comminuted to such a degree that all particles float or carry freely in suspension under flow conditions normally prevalent in the POTW, and which contains particles of a size not greater than one-half

(1/2) inch in any dimension; or other wastes including, but not limited to, bones, hair, hides or fleshings, whole blood, paunch manure recognizable portions of the human anatomy, tissue fluids, entrails, ashes, cinders, mud, straw, sand, wood, grass, rags, feathers, tar, asphalt residues, glass grinding or polishing wastes, plastics, spent grains, spent hops, waste paper, styrofoam and residues from refining or processing of fuel or lubricating oil;
