ORDINANCE No. 98-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1, SECTION 2; CLARIFYING AN EXISTING DEFINITION

WHEREAS, a definition stipulated in Ordinance No. 1 must be modified.

Now, THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Board of Directors of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority that Ordinance No. 1, Section 2 be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1

Section 2 - - DEFINITIONS is amended as follows:

The following language shall be added to the existing definition of Equivalent Dwelling Unit, (EDU):

"Each of the following class of users are equivalent to a minimum of 1 (one) EDU: each mobile home, each unit in a multi-unit apartment complex; each retail business or professional office, whether a sole building occupant or in a complex using a common restroom; each unit in a senior retirement complex with kitchen facilities."
