ORDINANCE #2003-01

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 23, Section 3; Establishing Sewer Charges to be Levied on all Users Discharging Wastewater to the Wastewater System, and Declaring an Emergency.

WHEREAS, the charges stipulated in Ordinance No. 23 must be modified.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority that Ordinance No. 23, Section 3, be, and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 1

Section 3.04 reads as follows:

The total rate charged a user shall consist of a user charge for debt service and a user charge for operations, including maintenance and replacement of the treatment works.

- a) The user charge for debt service will be a fixed amount to be charged user for each EDU of flow per month. The user charge per EDU shall be \$1.25 per month.
- b) The user charge for operations including operation, maintenance, and replacement of the treatment works shall be \$15.75 for each EDU per month.
- c) For those users who contribute wastewater with strength greater than domestic sewage, a surcharge, in addition to the normal user charge will be collected. The surcharge shall be based on the users proportionate share of the operation and maintenance (including replacement) of the treatment works.

The total rate to be charged a class of user based upon this Section is as follows:

<u>CLASS</u>		
Ι	Residential	\$17.00/month/EDU
II	Low Strength	\$17.00/month/EDU
III	High Strength	As determined individually by Calculation
IV	Industrial	As determined individually by Calculation

Section 2 - Emergency Clause

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors unanimously, by Roll Call Vote on June 11, 2003, passed a motion to increase sewer charges to \$17.00 per month, per EDU, and

WHEREAS, notice to all sewer users was mailed on August 19, 2003, to advise of the proposed sewer rate change, to be effective on September 1, 2003, and

WHEREAS, the utility billing system has been modified to reflect the new rate effective September 1, 2003, and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is necessary to establish the rate increase to be effective September 1, 2003;

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage by the Board of Directors.
