

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 693

An Ordinance to amend General Ordinance No. 657, as amended, by reducing the resident requirement of commissioners from three years to one year.

THE PEOPLE OF DALLES CITY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That General Ordinance No. 657 entitled "An Ordinance providing a system of civil service for the paid members of the Fire Department and the members of the Police Department, repealing Ordinance No. 568 passed March 5, 1937, approved March 7, 1937, as amended by Ordinance No. 615 passed and approved November 14, 1946, and repealing Ordinance No. 605 passed June 4, 1945, approved June 5, 1945, as amended by Ordinance No. 614 passed and approved November 14, 1946, and Ordinance No. 617 passed and approved December 21, 1946 and Ordinance No. 619 passed and approved December 21, 1946; and declaring an emergency", as amended by General Ordinance No. 673 passed and approved June 19, 1950, be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter set forth:

Section 2. That Section 2 of said Ordinance be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The civil service system of Dalles City shall be administered by the civil service commission, the members of which are appointed by the council. No person shall be appointed or qualified as a member of the commission who is not a citizen of the United States of America, a qualified elector of Dalles City, and who has not been a resident of the city for at least one year immediately preceding appointment. By resolution, the council may remove any member of the commission from office for incompetency, incompatibility, dereliction of duty, or malfeasance in office, or other good cause after giving to the commissioner a copy of the charges against him and an opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel upon not less than 10 days notice.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced, read once in full, and once by title only by unanimous vote, and passed by the following vote on the 21st day of January, 1952.
