

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 697

An Ordinance to amend General Ordinance No. 687 clarifying Section 5 (d) relating to multiple users on one connection, revising Section 6 (e) relating to flat rates for oversize connections.

THE PEOPLE OF DALLES CITY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That General Ordinance No. 687 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the administration and operation of the Water Department of Dalles City, providing for meters, deposits, and setting water rates," passed and approved June 5, 1951, be amended as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. That Section 5 (d) be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

No person shall take or use city water from premises other than his own, and no person shall sell or give away water from his own premises for any purpose. No connection through which water may pass from one property to another shall be constructed or permitted to remain in existence, even though the ownership of both properties may be the same. Provided, however, where such a condition is currently in existence at the time of the passage of this ordinance, the Superintendent may allow a reasonable time for the elimination of such a condition. During such temporary period, the combined minimum rates for each of the properties so connected or served shall be charged to the property having the direct connection to the water main, and the owner of that property shall make such arrangements with the users on the other properties for the payment of their fair share of the total consumption of water as may be deemed just and proper.

Section 3. That Section 6 (e) be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The following schedule of water rates is hereby established and shall be charged for water supplied by the Water Department:

Flat rate:	Single family residences.....	\$2.00 per month
	Two family residences.....	1.75 per month per unit
	Three family residences.....	1.50 per month " "
	Four family residences.....	1.25 per month " "
	All over four family residences .....	Meter Rate

Oversize connections: For oversize connections or for each extra tap to the water main the flat rates per month shall be increased according to the following scale: 3/4" - \$2.00; 1" - \$3.00; 1-1/2" - \$4.00; 2" - \$5.00; 3" - \$7.50; 4" - \$10.00; 6" - \$20.00; 8" - \$30.00.

Meter rate: All non-residential premises.

Minimum charge per month - \$2.00 which shall entitle the user to  
7,500 gallons of water during the month

For water consumed above the minimum:

\$.12 per thousand gallons for the next 5,000 gallons  
.08 per thousand gallons for the next 7,500 gallons  
.05 per thousand gallons above 20,000 gallons during the month

Outside rate: All premises served outside the city limits  
shall be metered at one and one-half ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ )  
times the regular city rates.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced and read once in full, and by  
unanimous vote the rules were suspended and the ordinance was read for the  
second time by title only, and passed this 22d day of July, 1952, by
