

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 815

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 731 as amended, relating to the accumulation of sick leave, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF DALLAS CITY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 731 entitled "An Ordinance pertaining to vacations, sick leave and holidays for City employees" passed and approved December 3, 1956, as amended, is amended as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. There is added to Ordinance No. 731, as amended, Section 2 A to read as follows:

Section 2 A. As of January 1, 1963 all full time city employees are declared to have accumulated sick leave at the rate of one day per consecutive month of employment prior to January 1, 1963 to a maximum accumulation of 45 days, less sick leave taken by the employee between the 1st day of April, 1959 and the 1st day of January, 1963.

Section 3. Inasmuch as it is in the interest of the public safety and welfare that sick leave accumulation policy be standard for employees of Dallas City, now, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
