

RESOLUTION NO. 2069

A RESOLUTION CALLING AN ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 4, 2003, IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON A FIVE YEAR FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004/2005 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2008/2009, AND ADOPTING A BALLOT TITLE TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY

The Warrenton City Commission resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. That an election be held on November 4, 2003, for the purpose of voting on a local option tax for police department operations. The local option tax will be a five year levy of \$.3514 per \$1,000 of assessed property value each year and, over the five year period, it is estimated that a total of \$513,988 will be expended for the purpose of funding this position.

SECTION 2. The ballot title, submitted directly to the people, shall be as follows:

CAPTION: Five Year Local Option Tax for Police Operations.

QUESTION: Shall City levy \$.3514 per \$1,000 of assessed value for fives years for police operations beginning 2004?
This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

SUMMARY: This measure may be passed only at an election with at least 50 percent voter turnout. The City will use this local option tax to operate the police department at its present level of services. Without this additional revenue, the City of Warrenton must eliminate one police officer position from the department. The proposed levy is .3514 per \$1,000 of assessed property value or \$35.14 per year on a \$100,000 house. The levy will begin in the tax year beginning July 1, 2004, and will end in the tax year ending June 30, 2009. The money raised can only be used for police operations.

It is estimated that this local option tax will raise approximately \$96,811 in 2004-2005, \$99,716.30 in 2005- 2006, \$102,707.79 in 2006 - 2007, \$105,789.02 in 2007-2008, and \$108,962.70 in 2008 - 2009, for a total of \$513,988 over the five year period.

SECTION 3. The Warrenton City Manager is hereby directed to give notice of said election, as required by law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 4, 2003, an election will be held in the City of Warrenton, Oregon. The ballot title for the local option serial levy, submitted to the electors, is as follows:

CAPTION: Five Year Local Option Tax for Police Operations.

QUESTION: Shall City levy \$.3514 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years for police operations, beginning 2004?
This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.
