Be it resolved that the City Commission of the City of Warrenton hereby levies the taxes provided for in the adopted budget at the permanent rate of \$ 1.6701 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for General Government, \$0.0950 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for the Library Local Option Levy, \$0.2676 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for the Fire Local Option Levy, \$0.2356 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for the Police Local Option Levy, and \$166,439 for bonded indebtedness excluded from the limitation, that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable properties within said city as of 1:00 AM January 1, 2003.
