## RESOLUTION NO. 2081

## **Introduced by All Commissioners**

## AUTHORIZING THE WARRENTON CITY COMMISSION, SITTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD TO EXEMPT THE PURCHASE OF A THERMAL IMAGING CAMERA FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING

The Warrenton City Commission, sitting as the Local Contract Review Board, makes the following findings:

(1) The City has received a donation from an anonymous donor restricted to the purchase of a specific brand thermal imaging device and accessories; and

(2) The amount of the donation will not cover the cost of other brands of thermal imaging devices and accessories.

Based on (1) and (2) above, the City finds (a), it is unlikely that this exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or diminish competition for public contracts, and (b), the exemption will result in substantial cost savings to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Warrenton Local Contract Review Board hereby exempts the acquisition of a thermal imaging camera and accessories from the competitive bidding requirements of ORS 279.015 and the ordinances of this City.
