

ORDINANCE NO. 367

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATER RATES FOR MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF PHOENIX ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The water service charge for all multiple family residences shall be as set forth herein. "Multiple Family Residences" shall include duplexes, apartment houses, mobile home parks, travel trailer parks and any other residence other than a single family residence.


SECTION 2. The charge for water service is Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3.50) per month multiplied by the number of residential units in the multiple family residence, plus Fifteen Cents (15¢) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water that is used during the month by the entire multiple family residence that is in excess of seven (700) hundred cubic feet of water multiplied by the number of units in the multiple family residence.

SECTION 3. The owner of the multiple family residence or mobile home park shall be responsible for these water service charges and shall pay these sums to the City of Phoenix.

SECTION 4. The water service charge for each newly constructed multiple family residence unit shall commence from the date that the water service is first furnished to such unit.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective commencing March 1, 1974.
