

Ordinance No. 5

Entitled,

An Ordinance Providing for the  
Compensation of the Auditor and Police  
Judge, Treasurer and Attorney of the  
City of Warrnton, Oregon.

The City of Warrnton Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. <sup>Salary of Auditor & Police Judge</sup> The Auditor and Police Judge  
of the City of Warrnton, shall, in addition  
to the compensation provided for said officers  
in the Charter of said City, receive for his  
services a salary of One Hundred and Twenty  
Dollars per year, from the date of his ap-  
pointment to office, payable in four  
installments, <sup>equal</sup> installments to be paid  
quarterly.

Section 2. <sup>Treasurer's Salary</sup> The Treasurer of the City of  
Warrnton shall receive for the services  
rendered by said officer to the City,  
the actual expenses which he may incur  
in the transaction of his business for  
the City, which expense shall be audited  
and paid as other demands against  
said City.

Section 3. <sup>Salary of Attorney</sup> The Attorney of the City of  
Warrnton shall receive for the services  
rendered by said officer to said City a  
salary of One Hundred and Eighty Dollars

per year, from the date of his appointment to office. payable in four instalments, one instalment to be paid each quarter.

Section 4. <sup>Extra services of officers to be paid.</sup> For any extraordinary services rendered by any of the aforesaid officers to said City, such service shall be paid for by the Council in such manner and amount as they may prescribe.
