AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF IMPROVING Third Street from Railroad Avenue to the East Side of Elm Street, in the City of Warrenton, Or.

Whereas, notice of the intention of the City Council of Warrenton, Oregon to improve Third Street from Railroad Avenue to the East Side of Elm Street,

in that part of the said city known as Warrens First Addition to Warrenton, has been given by publication thereof in the Port Oregon Tribune, a weekly newspaper published in said city, for the time and in the manner by the charter of said city required, and

Whereas, no remonstrance against said proposed improvement has been made or filed with the Auditor and police judge of said city within the time by said charter required, and

Whereas, the City Surveyor, under the direction of the said council has made and deposited with said Auditor and police Judge plans and specifications for the proposed work upon said improvement and an estimate of the expense thereof and a map of the district to be assessed for the same, now therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That Third Street from Railway Avenue (formerly called Railroad Avenue) to the east side of Elm Street in the City of Warrenton, Or. be and the same is

hereby ordered improved by grading same where necessary and planting same when so graded, to a width of eight feet on each side of a line drawn through the center of said Third Street, from said Railroad Avenue to Elm Street. The planting to be laid upon suitable stumps three feet apart, said plant to be three inches thick, also constructing side walks on the north side of said Third St. for three feet to the west side of Elm Street, whose side walk shall be six feet wide and be constructed of brick or stone, and ditching same clear under same of sufficient capacity to properly drain said Third Street and side walks.

Sec. 2. said improvement shall be constructed according to the plans and specifications therefor, which are now on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge of said city, are hereby referred to and made a part and parcel of this ordinance, and all material to be used on said improvement shall be as in said specifications provided.

Sec. 3. The Committee on Streets and Public Improvements are hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement, by publication of a notice therefor in the Port Oregon Tribune, for one issue of said paper, and said committee are hereby authorized for and on behalf of said city to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, for the construction of said improvement, provided, that no bids shall be received, or considered which shall exceed the estimate of the expense of said improvement now on file in the office of the said Auditor and Police Judge and hereby made a part of this ordinance.

Sec. 4. Said improvement shall be completed on or before the 15 day of October, 1899 and for every day thereafter which the contractor for said improvement shall consume in the completion of the same, he shall forfeit to the said city the sum of \$ 5.00, to be deducted from the amount due him at the time of the payment for said work.

Sec. 5. The said work shall be done under the supervision of the Marshall of said city who is hereby made the inspector of said work, with power to stop said work at any time he is satisfied that any work is being done with material is being used on said work which does not conform to this ordinance.
