Rule Concept: Commingled Recycling Processing Facility Permit Program – Fees

Plastic Pollution and Recycling Modernization Act (SB 582, 2021)

Background

This memo introduces a draft rule concept establishing the fees for the Commingled Recycling Processing Facility permit program.

ORS 459A.955 requires that a person may not establish or operate a commingled recycling processing facility in the State of Oregon unless the person obtains a disposal site permit issued by DEQ. Concepts related to a new disposal permit specific to CRPFs were presented to the rulemaking advisory committee in November 2023. The purpose of this rule concept is to establish the permit application processing fee and the annual permit compliance fee associated with the new Commingled Recycling Processing Facility permit program.

Rule concept for discussion at the April 3, 2024 RAC meeting

For the new Commingled Recycling Processing Facility permit program, DEQ proposes to update OAR 340-097-0120 to apply the fee structure already used for transfer stations and material recovery facilities to CRPFs:

- A permit application fee of \$100 – \$500, to be assessed based on the anticipated tons received annually by the facility.
- An annual permit compliance fee of \$50 – \$1,000, to be assessed based on the tons accepted annually by the facility.
