Don:

Go over history of Ice Cream Social

History of Property - Clarence Heater, 1969, negotiated with County to use property for

substation (\$4700)

Duane:

County portion (North part) to be used for public purpose

John:

Discrepancy, John Paola says he is the one who got this going

Donna:

Property is designated partially for a park.

Park and benches and landscaping

Don:

Neighbors concerned about where to walk dogs

Anyone gone thru the minutes of that time period?

Duane:

He has, but there is very little info

Just meet expectations (public use of park)

Don:

Would park be responsibility of City or Parl & Rec.

Donna:

City's responsibility

Duane:

Doesn't think we need to make decision now about who maintains

Don:

No money in the budget for park

Bert:

Put sign up "Future Park"

Donna:

PGE will give trees and fire station needs to be landscaped anyway

Michael:

Handed out ISO information and went over information

Donna:

Hopp Insurance - 5 different companies would n't change rate until a 5. If have sufficient

equipment and fire hydrants rating good, and Newberg is good.

Michael: Went over other factors influencing rating, training, etc., staffing, water department/fire

department (how good they are). Very complicated issue (ISO ratings)

John: How does rating system work in rural district - after 5 mile radius goes from a 3 to an 8.

Michael: Went over how substation will effect rural district

Don: Reason for station - pull more volunteers 3-4 years, will be manned as well as present

station. 5 years before as functional as present station

Michael: Present model best way to go to assure a quality operation.

Handed out substation information that was handed out at the social. 200 - 220 adults, 250

ice creams.

Lisa: Ice cream social big success - comments about why station was not built already.

Estella: Some neighbors against substation

Don: Felt was success (volunteer)

Bert: How many sign ups for volunteers

Don: 3 came from survey

Michael: Daycare at station for volunteers

Don: Hand out breakdown and financial estimates

Michael: Went over estimate

Eric: What if bids were more than estimates

Michael: Have contingencies - figures quite detailed

Always a chance of something goofy

Charles: Where is landscaping

Michael: Assumes site work

Charles: Cost per square

Michael: \$36.40/100 thousand - 20 year bond

Lisa: Same? About part of fire station in budget for police?

Michael: Roof on present building expenses in general fund.

Eric: Cost of removing asbestos - do we have good figures

Michael: Architect has all info - guess we have to trust

Eric: Is this the best place for substation?

Michael: East end of town more calls. ISO looks at these figures. Smaller substation North end.

Eric: If doesn't pass, what to do?

Michael: Go back in next general election if majority approve. If majority doesn't approve - no need

to pursue

Duane: Difficult to get adequate voter turn out. Haven't had 50% unless general election.

Countywide fuel tax may also be on ballot - cost could be \$5,000. to get on ballot

Michael: If there's enough support and legwork its doable

Eric: Would City budget be able to support staff

Duane: Not at present budget

Eric: Could you man with volunteers

Michael: Will work on this and then have to go back to City

Eric: Concerned about having building and no staff

Michael: 4 career staff will go out of the present 9

Duane: Same as school issues when community grows, can staff now but will not be adequate

forever

Michael: Talked about the healthy volunteer organization we have

Eric: Square footage?

Michael: 8300

Eric: What type of construction?

Michael: Tilt up or block - floors 6" reinforced

Eric:

? Remodel cost of present building?

Michael:

Architect didn't separate them out - any could end up short - might have to cut

Eric:

? About service area of substation - is it to service Crater area and is the response time

good?

Michael:

Not to service Crater area (there is to be another substation [Rural District])

John:

Cost per square foot

Michael:

\$120 per square foot

John:

8300 Square feet?

Michael:

Actually 9000 square feet

Don:

Reconfirm to go ahead and put on ballot

Bert:

Thinks thats affirmative quorum present)

Don:

Ask if any other discussion

Bert:

Adjourn meeting
