Meeting Notes:

- FS Residual Risk Assessment
 - HAI/AQ previously asked for examples of residual risk assessments. DEQ previously provided an example from the Pope and Talbot Site (Port of Columbia County). Based on example, HAI/AQ do not have additional questions about the residual risk assessment for the Gasco OU FS.
- April 11 Meeting Planning
 - HAI/AQ confirm the agenda for the meeting (DNAPL evaluation in bulk ISS treatment area, Segment 3 groundwater screening, hot spots, and FS schedule).
 - HAI notes that during the meeting, they plan to discuss a preference for extending the ISS barrier wall further south on the Siltronic property as part of the IRAM based on the Segment 3 groundwater screening.
 - DEQ needs to think about how that might be done administratively. We would need NW Natural to present an evaluation that establishes why the ISS wall in that area is necessary, and we would need to allow project stakeholders to review that information and provide feedback. DEQ thinks it would be administratively easier to use the FS to provide the necessary justification.
 - HAI/AQ indicate that AQ technical staff are planning to call into the meeting and will be available to answer DEQ's technical questions about the analyses presented.
 - DEQ states that we were not planning to get into a deeply technical discussion during the meeting. We would want the opportunity to review the information in more detail before we drew definitive conclusions or provided agreement. Our goal is to finalize agreements on the scope of the IRAM and resolve any outstanding questions related to the FS.
- Future Geotechnical Investigations
 - NW Natural is planning to conduct a geotechnical investigation to support a seismic evaluation of tank infrastructure on the sites. HAI will coordinate scope of work, including means and methods and IDW handling with DEQ.
- PGE Investigations
 - HAI asks about status of PGE investigations on Siltronic's property.
 - DEQ believes that the sampling work was delayed while PGE got access agreements in place. Some of the pole locations may have been moved as well.
- Doane Creek SCE
 - AQ has started the Doane Creek SCE revisions, but has prioritized the FS and IRAM over the past couple of months. AQ can check in and provide a status update in future meetings.
- Doane Creek Sampling
 - Sampling planned for late April. Based on access agreement conditions, it appears to difficult to coordinate a site visit.
