

RESOLUTION NO. 21-81

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR IMPROVEMENT WORK ON THE ORDINANCE  
COMPILATION OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, statutory and constitutional changes and court rulings  
have occurred since the compilation of the ordinances of the city  
of Vernonia, Oregon in Nov., 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the city council that these legal  
changes and other developments warrant the review and improvement  
of the present city ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the improvement of the compilation involving the  
elimination of obsolete, invalid and conflicting ordinances is a  
technical and time consuming task beyond the scope of work of the  
present regular officers and employes of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Governmental Research and Service of the  
University of Oregon and the League of Oregon Cities, in their efforts  
to promote better and more efficient municipal government, are willing  
to undertake improvement work on the city's compilation; now, there-  
fore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the city of Vernonia, Oregon hereby  
authorizes and requests the Bureau of Governmental Research and  
Service, under its cooperative program of joint services with the  
League of Oregon Cities, to carry out the improvement work on the  
ordinance compilation of the city at cost according to the standard  
rates for services under the program.
