> RE: No Further Action Determination for Enterprise Chevron In Enterprise, Wallowa County [LUST #32-98-0010]

Dear Mr. Byrnes:

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has completed a review of the available information and the closure report entitled "Site Investigation and Risk-Based Closure Report", dated June 23, 2023, and submitted to DEQ on your behalf. The Enterprise Chevron address is 111 NW 1st Street, Enterprise, Oregon [Tax Lot 400; Range 2 South; Township 44 East; Section 2AB].

DEQ has determined that remedial action to address environmental contamination at Enterprise Chevron is complete, and no further action is required. This determination is based on the DEQ regulations and the facts as we now understand them including, but not limited to the following:

- The site has been operating as a service station with convenience store since at least 1981.
- Contamination resulted from a release from the UST System.
- Soil and groundwater are the affected media.
- Remedial actions taken:
 - o In May 1998, a 1,000-gallon gasoline UST was decommissioned and 80 yards of petroleum contaminated soil was removed.
 - o Additional site characterization occurred in October 2008.
 - o In 2020, DEQ approved the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to further evaluate the risks still present at the site. The CAP was executed and the need for additional information was identified.
 - o In 2021, An additional Soil and Groundwater Investigation was completed.
- A small amount of residual contamination remains in place, but at concentrations well below the Risk-Based Concentrations.
- The site will remain in use as a service station and convenience store for the foreseeable future, therefore land and water use will remain unchanged.

Based on the available information, Enterprise Chevron is currently protective of public health and the environment. The site requires no further action under the Oregon Environmental Cleanup Law, ORS 465.200 et seq. and under Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 340-122-0205 through 340-122-0360 unless new or previously undisclosed information becomes available, or there are changes in site development or land and

water uses, or more contamination is discovered. DEQ will update the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) database to reflect this decision.

If any contaminated soil or groundwater is encountered in the future, it must be handled and disposed of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
