11	1. <u>Findings</u>					
12	A. On January 7, 2019, the Multnoma	h County Circuit Court entered a Consent Judgment				
13	in Case No. 18CV54321 (the "Consent Judgment") regarding Prospective Purchaser Agreement					
14	(PPA) DEQ No. 18-06 entered into by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)					
15	with Oregon Humane Society (OHS). PPA DEQ No. 18-06 concerns the property at					
16	7865 NE 14 <sup>th</sup> Place (formerly 1409-1411 NE Columbia Boulevard) in Portland, Oregon (tax lot					
17	1N1E11DC -01800; the "Site"). The Site has been assigned Environmental Cleanup Site					
18	Information (ECSI) file No. 4017 by DEQ. Under the terms of the PPA, OHS agreed to perform					
19	and comply with all applicable provisions of the Consent Judgment and to work under DEQ					
20	oversight to perform agreed upon measures at its own cost.					
21	B. The Consent Judgment designated the work to be performed in a Scope of Work					
22	(SOW) attached to and incorporated by reference into the Consent Judgment as Attachment C. The					
23	SOW required: completion of a Focused Phase 2 Environmental Site Assessment investigation and					
24	report per a DEQ-approved work plan; providing historical environmental reports specified by					
25	5 DEQ; completion of a Stormwater Source Control Evaluation per a DEQ-approved wok plan;					
26	26 implementation of a DEQ-approved Contaminated Media Management Plan during re-

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- 2 Easement and Equitable Servitudes, and/or implementation of an Operation & Maintenance Plan if
- 3 unacceptable risk is found during the investigation.
- 4 C. All of the work described in Section B, above, was fully performed and is documented
- 5 in the plans and reports in the Administrative Record, including a report entitled *Technical*
- 6 Memorandum, Supplemental Contaminated Media Management Plan Implementation Report dated
- 7 October 10, 2022 and prepared by Creekside Environmental Consulting, LLC, and an August 1,
- 8 2023 Stormwater Source Control Evaluation Report prepared by Evren Northwest. All plans and
- 9 reports are referenced under the name of Oregon Humane Society, ECSI No. 4017, in the files of
- 10 DEQ's Environmental Cleanup Program at the Northwest Region Office in Portland, Oregon.
- D. On September 1, 2023, DEQ provided public notice and opportunity to comment on a
- 12 proposed Certification of Completion determination for the facility in accordance with ORS 465.320
- and 465.325(10)(b). Copies of the work plans and reports completed for the project were available
- 14 for review on DEQ's database and at DEQ's Northwest Region office in Portland. The public
- notice was published on September 1, 2023, in the *Oregon Secretary of State's Bulletin*, and in the
- 16 Oregonian on September 1, 2023. The comment period was closed on October 2, 2023. No
- 17 comments were received.
- 18 E. Based on the reports and other information submitted by OHS, any information
- 19 received during public notice and comment period, and upon DEQ's inspection and oversight of
- 20 activities, DEQ finds that OHS satisfactorily completed the PPASOW.

## 21 **2.** Conclusions

- A. OHS has satisfactorily completed remedial actions at the Site per DEQ-approved plans
- as required under the Consent Judgment. DEQ concludes that, because all environmental concerns
- 24 have been addressed, issuance of a Conditional No Further Action determination is warranted.
- B. No further remedial actions are required at the Site to protect the public health, safety,
- and welfare or the environment.
