

ORDINANCE NO. 1734

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DOGS FROM ROAMING AT LARGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEWBERG, OREGON; AUTHORIZING THE IMPOUNDING AND DESTRUCTION OF DOGS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH;

The People of the City of Newberg do ordain as follows:

Section 1. All persons owning dogs, or having them under their control, shall keep them confined on their premises, or upon taking such dog, or dogs, upon the street, sidewalks or other public property or building in the City of Newberg, shall keep such dog, or dogs, on a leash or in the control of the person then having said dog, or dogs in their possession.


Section 2. Any dog found off the premises of its owner, or off the premises of the person having control of such animal, shall be subject to being picked up and confined in a place of confinement selected by the City Council of the City of Newberg.

Section 3. The owner, or person in control of such dog so picked up and/or confined, may reclaim said animal upon paying to the City Recorder of the City of Newberg \$7.00 per day for the care of such animal, and the term "one day" shall include any part of a day.


Section 4. After a dog has been in confinement for a period of five days such animal may be disposed of or destroyed upon the written order of the Chief of Police.

Section 5. Penalties - A person who violates this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00 or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than 90 days or by both.
