12	1. <u>Findings</u>				
13	A. On March 25, 2019, the Clatsop County Circuit Court entered a Consent Judgment in				
14	Case No. 19CV13270 (the "Consent Judgment") between Oregon Department of Environmental				
15	Quality (DEQ) with Astoria Marine Construction Company (AMCCO) concerning the property at				
16	92134 Front Road in Astoria, Oregon (the "Site"). The Site is comprised of Clatsop County tax lots				
17	81025DD00800, 81025DD00900, 81025DD01000 and 81025DA05000, and has been assigned				
18	Environmental Cleanup Site Information (ECSI) file No. 1898 by DEQ. Under the terms of the				
19	Consent Judgment, AMCCO agreed to perform and comply with all applicable provisions of the				
20	Consent Judgment and to work under DEQ oversight to perform agreed upon measures at its own cost.				
21	B. The Consent Judgment designated to	the work to be performed in a Scope of Work			
22	(SOW) attached to and incorporated by reference into the Consent Judgment as Attachment B. The				
23	SOW included completion of a remedial investigation and feasibility study, and implementation of a				
24	soil and sediment remedy. Remedial work included the following elements:				
25	• Excavation and off-site removal and disposal of contaminated soil (e.g., hot spots)				
26	Capping of the on-site soils that show contaminants at lower concentrations				

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1	<ul> <li>Modification of the upland stormwater system to reduce migration of residually</li> </ul>		
2	contaminated soil		
3	• Excavation and off-site removal and disposal of contaminated sediment		
4	• Placement of a sand layer above residual sediment contamination and enhanced		
5	monitored natural recovery (EMNR)		
6	• Institutional controls to maintain the upland soil cap and manage the sediment remedy		
7	Long-term monitoring and maintenance for sediment recovery		
8	C. Except for long-term monitoring and maintenance for sediment recovery, which DEQ		
9	will perform, all of the work described in Section B, above, was fully performed and is documented		
10	in the plans and reports in the Administrative Record, including a January 25, 2024 report entitled		
11	AMCCO Remedial Action Construction Certification Report prepared by Maul Foster and Alongi.		
12	All plans and reports are referenced under the name of Astoria Marine Construction Company,		
13	ECSI No. 1898, in the files of DEQ's Environmental Cleanup Program at the Northwest Region		
14	Office in Portland, Oregon.		
15	D. On February 1, 2024, DEQ provided public notice and opportunity to comment on a		
16	proposed Certification of Completion determination for the facility in accordance with ORS 465.320		
17	and 465.325(10)(b). Copies of the work plans and reports completed for the project were available		
18	for review on DEQ's database and at DEQ's Northwest Region office in Portland. The public		
19	notice was published on February 1 in the Oregon Secretary of State's Bulletin, and in the Astorian		
20	newspaper. The comment period was closed on March 4, 2024. No comments were received.		
21	E. Based on the reports and other information submitted by AMCCO, any information		
22	received during public notice and comment period, and upon DEQ's inspection and oversight of		
23	activities, DEQ finds that AMCCO satisfactorily completed the SOW.		
24	2. <u>Conclusions</u>		
25	A. AMCCO has satisfactorily completed remedial actions at the Site per DEQ-approved		
26	plans as required under the Consent Judgment. DEQ concludes that, because all environmental		

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1	concerns have been addressed, issuance of a Conditional No Further Action determination is					
2	warranted.					
3		B. No further remedial actions are requi	ired at the Sit	e to protect the public health, safety,		
4	and welfare or the environment.					
5	3. <u>Conditions</u>					
6	A. This Certification of Completion applies only to the satisfactory completion of the					
7	work conducted by AMCCO pursuant to the Consent Judgment.					
8	B. DEQ does not, by this Certification, assume liability for any claim arising from acts or					
9	omissions of AMCCO or its officers, employees, agents, successors, subsidiaries, or assigns relating					
10	to actions pursuant to the Consent Judgment.					
11	4. <u>Notice</u>					
12	This order constitutes Certification of Completion under ORS 465.325(10) and may be					
13	appealed by any aggrieved person in accordance with ORS 465.325(10)(c).
